MAP - A new map, with fieldwork and cartography by Kevin Vigar. Crop and grazing land interspersed with numerous salt lakes, flat with minor undulations. Generally fast run with route choice varying according to the season. Has one significant area of scrub consisting of mallee, she-oak and melaleuca.

CLASSES -

Relays - A (hard navigation, legs of approx. 4.5 km)

B (moderate to hard navigation, legs of approx. 3.5 km)

C (moderate to easy navigation, legs of approx. 2.0 km)

* This is an annual competition between the Saltbush and Lincoln clubs.

Other clubs, or individuals, are invited to submit teams but will be ineligible for trophies.

Required by Sat. July 31st. If you would like to make up a composite team for the Relays, please indicate what level you would like to contest - A, B, or C. Enter-on-the-day courses will be available on Saturday from 1.00 pm and on Sunday from 11.00 am.

Saturday at 12.30 pm and on Sunday from 10.00 am.

CAMPING -

Kapinnie Sportsground has been chosen as our event centre. Toilets, hot showers and kitchen facilities are available. Unpowered campsites may be found, or swag space on the floor of the old change rooms. This will be available on the Friday and Saturday at a rate of \$10.00 per person.

SIGNS to the event area -

From Port Lincoln, take Flinders Highway and Tod Highway to Cummins, then the Bratten Way to Kapinnie and Mount Hope - signs begin 11 kms from Cummins at Yeltukka road. From Whyalla, turn right off the Lincoln Highway at Brayfield (approx. 10 km south of Port Neill) to Ungarra and Yeelanna. Kapinnie is 26 km from Yeelanna - signs from the Tod Highway at Yeelanna.

CATERING -

A barbeque lunch with salads will be available at the assembly area on Sunday. You will need to provide your own food for all other meals. The nearest shops (IGA store) are at Cummins.
